

Overview of Project Management

- A Project is any planned, collaborative effort that is designed to achieve an objective.
 - Key elements are tasks and staff
 - Tasks define Project work
 - Staff are resources who perform the work
- Top Project Constraints are time, cost, and resources
 - ServiceNow PPM lets you manage each constraint
 - Determine Project length
 - Determine cost based on resource actual hours (Timesheets)
- ServiceNow PPM has the flexibility to manage your Project throughout the life of the Project, adapting to changing complexity or business demands (Risks, Issues and Change Requests).
