Resource Plan States: Who Can Do What and When?

Resource Plan States

Notes:

Request Change on a Requested or Confirmed resource plan puts the resource plan back in Planning state.
Altering the resource plan record itself on an Allocated resource plan puts it back in Requested state.

- Only **Admins** can edit an Allocated resource plan where the start date is today or earlier.
- Extend Resource Plan only shows when in Allocated state and start date is today or earlier (can update end date directly if the start date is in the future).
- Rejected plans have the **Rejected** state, which works the same as **Planning**.

Allocated	 Cannot edit resource plan but can Request Extension on resource plan to have the RM extend the end date Can edit planned hours distribution over time Can Complete the resource plan 	 Can edit the resource plan if the start date is in the future Can edit Planned hours and Conf/Alloc hours Can extend the resource plan end date Can Complete the resource plan
